Imagine if they had decided to stop as soon as they had been ordered to stop, especially when they had been threatened. Where would the Church be today? Where would we be today? Thankfully the Apostles had the faith to keep sharing the good news and in doing so they got to experience the grace of helping others know Jesus. Just imagine the great joy they felt being part of God's work.

Actually we don't have to imagine this joy because Jesus is sending us on the same mission as he sent the Apostles. He wants us to share our faith with others so they might also get to know him. We need to make this our mission. Sure we will probably run into some opposition, but we must have faith. We must also think about the many people who are searching and that we might be the ones who can help them find what they truly need, Jesus. What better way to follow the new commandment that Jesus tells us in today's Gospel, "love one another." "As I have loved you, so you also should love one another."

We just need to look at the crucifix to see how much Jesus loves us. Doesn't it seem as though we should be able to handle the possible insults, funny looks, even rude comments from some people as we share our love for Jesus with others. Jesus isn't telling us to force our faith on others, we just need to share our faith and the people who are searching might be open to learn more. If some aren't, it just means that they aren't ready yet. If we just go and announce the good news of the Lord **with love**, we will have the opportunity to experience the great joy of being part of God's and Jesus' plan to be His disciples.
