Yesterday at the Cathedral Basilica of Ss. Peter and Paul, six men were ordained to the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia (one being our own Fr. Brandon Artman). Throughout the next month ordinations will take place in many other dioceses and soon the newest priests will arrive at their first assignments as priests. What an exciting time for these men, their families and the church. Recently, Fr. Arul celebrated his twenty-eighth anniversary of Ordination, while this week Fr. O'Donnell and I will celebrate our Ordination anniversaries.

I think I can speak on behalf of Fr. Arul and Fr. O'Donnell as I reflect upon the years since our ordination. The many people with whom we have crossed paths, the couples whom we have married; families whose lives we have become part while comforting them at the death of a loved one; babies we have baptized; the parishes, schools and even foreign countries in which we have served have all left an incredible mark on our lives. On the day of our Ordination none of us could have ever realize the overwhelming gift that had been given to us, nor the adventure that awaited us. Today, however, I can say one thing for certain, we have received much more than we could ever give.

I am sometimes overwhelmed by this great gift that God has given to me, as His priests. I have said it in previous letters, but need to say it again, I feel truly blessed to be called to serve with you; to become part of your lives and the lives of your family. Know that I am grateful to God for calling me to His priesthood and ask your continued prayers, love and support.

In these times our Church faces many challenges. Among those challenges is the continued decline in the number of men ordained each year. As a child I can remember my home parish (St. Patrick's in Norristown) having three priests serving the needs of the parishioners. Yet, today there is only one priest assigned to that parish. I am certain that each of you can recall stories of two, three and even sometimes four priests being assigned to parishes that today are "one man" parishes.

I guess what leaves me so perplexed is that I cannot imagine my life as anything but a priest and want others to share the overwhelming gift of the priesthood. So I urge you to pray for more vocations to the priesthood. I plead with you to pray for the young men of our parish and archdiocese who may be contemplating a religious vocation. And I ask you to encourage vocations among your family; extend the invitation to a young man to serve the church as a priest.

Let us pray, through the intercession of St. John Vianney, patron Saint of Parish Priests, that other young men will be open to God calling them to His gift of the Priesthood.

Memorial Day Mass to honor all those who died serving our country in the Armed Forces will be celebrated on Monday, May 28th at 9:00 AM.




An Ordination Celebration


