Share in the Attitude of Christ

It seems in today's world we are moving more towards thinking and doing things about oneself. Even if things are done for others, it can be used to help bring glory to oneself. In today's Second Reading, St. Paul reminds us that we must strive for the same humility as Christ. He tells us we must **"do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory."** Yet so many times we are doing things for ourselves. We make ourselves into gods by doing things that we believe is right for us. We don't always think about how the things we are doing can or do affect others. Many people believe that it is their life, and they can live it however they wish.

Can we look at how we live our lives and live the way St. Paul tell us by **humbly regarding others as more important than ourselves, each looking out not for our own interests**, but also for those of others? Even if we try, our culture tells us differently. We may feel we must do what is best for us. Some do it at the expense of others. We all want to feel important and have others respect us.

Yet can we remind ourselves that God feels we are important, that He loves us and will take care of us better than we can take care of ourselves, because He knows what we need. If we know He loves us and knows we are important then why do we need to prove to others and ourselves how important we are? St. Paul tells us we must have the same attitude of Jesus. He reminds us **"Who, though he was in the form of God did not regard equality with God."** Jesus humbled himself for our sake.

Are we willing to find the strength to be humble as Christ is humble? It is through this humility that we can grow in our faith and help others grow in their faith, because we share in the selfless love of God. It is through prayer and the Eucharist that we can gain the strength we need to grow in this humility. So, we need to ask Jesus to share with us the grace to grow in humility as we receive Him in the Eucharist.

Evening Prayer, Procession and Benediction on Tuesday at 7:00 PM.

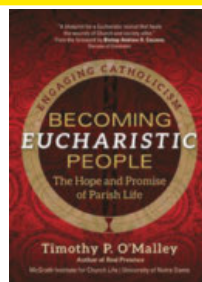
