I also enjoy Halloween, seeing the children in their costumes, and like to see the creative Halloween decorations that appear in our neighborhood. October can be a fun, colorful month!

From the Pastor's Desk

For Saint Patrick Parish, we celebrate our annual Forty Hours Devotion, which will be held October 15, 16, and 17. The Forty Hours Devotion is a special time of prayerful retreat as we have extended opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration, Evening Prayer, and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Our Guest Homilist will be Father Kyle M. Adamczyk. Of Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction, Pope Saint John XXIII wrote, "The Eucharistic blessing shows us how close Jesus is to our humble lives. 'God with us.' His blessing falls upon our troubles and afflictions, our anxieties and temptations, our failings and weaknesses, which in that moment we do not try to hide from him, and also upon the frailties of our spirit, upon circumstances the dangers of which are not yet apparent to us; upon the evil spirits who try to scare and bewilder us; and upon our beloved and faithful Guardian Angels, as if to reward them for their loving care" (printed in Praying In The Presence Of Our Lord: Prayers for Eucharistic Adoration, by Fr. Benedict J. Groeschel, C.F.R.). Mindful of these abundant blessings, how can we stay away?

The month of October also is the month of the Holy Rosary. The Church, for eight centuries, has recommended and propagated this important devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Rosary is a beautiful tool for the mission of evangelization and a powerful weapon against sin and evil. Through the Rosary, we unite ourselves in prayer with Mary as she contemplates the Holy Face of Jesus. While in each decade we pray in succession the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be, we meditate on the Birth, Life, Death and Resurrection of Jesus. Through this simple and magnificent prayer, we learn to imitate the mysteries upon which we reflect. Many favors and miracles have been obtained through the Rosary, and many blessings are bestowed upon those who encourage and teach others to pray the Rosary.

Visit the Blessed Sacrament often! Pray the Rosary daily! These will enhance your love for the Mass and Holy Communion, and soon they will become your favorite devotions!






