

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind...
You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

With these words, Our Blessed Lord summarized the commandments of God and has placed before us a "mission statement" for our lives. The love of God is the most creative force in the universe, and He has placed within our hearts the ability to love with His own love. As we see in our world so much disunity and hatred, we must recognize the presence of the chaotic hand of Satan. The Devil sows discord and malice, while Christ, through His Church, calls us to sow the Gospel of mercy, love and peace. Pope Benedict XVI taught, "The unbreakable bond between love of God and love of neighbor is emphasized. Immersed in divine love, the Saints showered that love on others in every circumstance. "The Saints were not superhuman," declared Pope Francis. "They were people who loved God in their hearts, and who shared this joy with others." May God grant to all of us the desire to be the saints He has created us to be.






