Staff Reflection

“Practice what you preach.” Many of us know that it is difficult to follow a leader or a group of people if they are clearly not living out the message they are claiming to own. In our Gospel, Jesus points out the hypocrisy of the Pharisees, who are not practicing what they preach. Instead of using their teaching authority to love and support others, the Pharisees use their power to give themselves the place of honor at the table. So where did the Pharisees go wrong? Jesus quickly reveals the root of the Pharisees' sin: pride.

In his work *Mere Christianity*, C.S. Lewis wrote, “A proud man is always looking down on things and people; and of course, as long as you are looking down, you cannot see something that is above you.” The Pharisees are looking down on others and are incapable of seeing God in their midst. Pride completely clouds their vision, and they become incapable of seeing the goodness in others. This pride makes us so concerned about our own status that we treat others as less worthy than ourselves. When we fall victim to pride, we are robbed of the joy that comes from delighting in others, which is no way to live as a Christian. Instead of becoming prideful, Jesus challenges us to cultivate the virtue of humility.

I will be the first to admit that humility does not come easy to me. I take myself too seriously, and I am quick to judge others when they do not do the same. I end up desiring a “place of honor” for myself instead of for others. This pride keeps me from practicing the grace and mercy that I claim to preach as a follower of Christ.

So what is the answer to my pride problem? I believe that pride is the root of all sin, so I do not think there is an easy solution. However, Jesus challenges me to see myself as little and in need of Him as my savior. The prideful yoke that I place on myself and others is heavy and unwieldy. In contrast, the yoke of Jesus, as we know, is easy and light. To follow Christ means that I am called to put others first, and to be sensitive to situations in which others are being put down. Instead of glorifying myself and looking down on others, I choose to commit myself to setting my eyes on God, and to reminding myself that the place of honor belongs to Him. In this way, I can begin to practice what I preach.

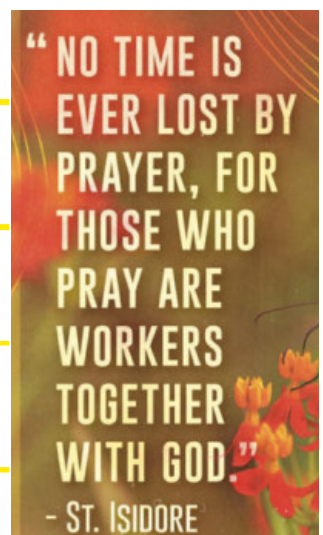

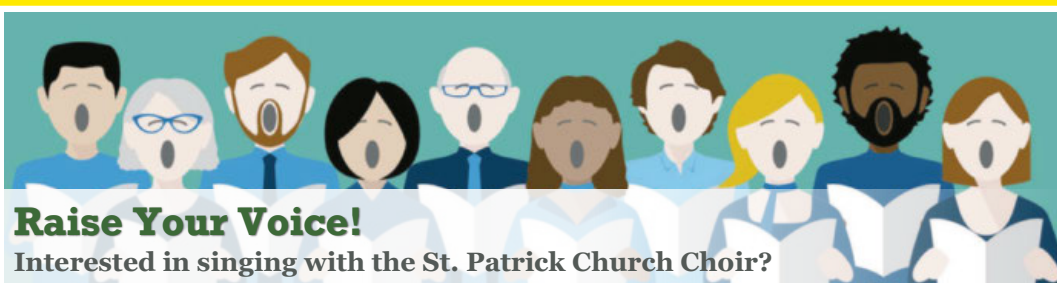

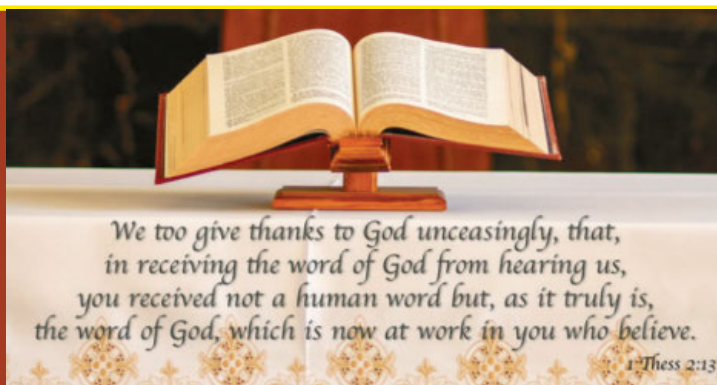
Adult Choir
