Staff Reflection

No do-overs

We all want to go to heaven. Just not right now it seems. But, what happens to us after we die is all something we are all going to face. Some people fear death. Some people actually look toward the end of their life here with great anticipation of meeting our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and coming face to face with God, witnessing His divine glory, and bathing in His perfect love and joy. Without question, God wants us with Him. There should be no doubt about that at all. He is a God of mercy and love. “For God so loved the world that he gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life.” John 3:16. We all know the Scripture passage. So, are we all going to heaven? No. While it is true that Jesus opened the door to heaven for us with His Passion, Death, and Resurrection, and He redeemed us from our sins, and He absolutely wants us with him, the reality is that so many choose not to love God, follow Him, or do what it is He asks of us. We must choose Him. God is a God of love, God loves us so much that He does not force Himself upon us. He loves us so much that He has given us free will, which includes the option to choose something other than Him. This is because God knows that love is only true if it is free. None of us want someone to love us because they have to. We all want someone to love us because they want to. God wants us to love Him because we want to, not because we have to, because then it isn’t real love.

In the Gospel today, Jesus explains in very clear terms how we love God. We love God...by loving each other. We love God by giving food to the hungry. We love God when we give a drink to someone who is thirsty, by welcoming a stranger, by giving some of our clothes to those who otherwise wouldn’t have something to wear. When we do these things, and care for the sick, or visit someone in prison, then we are loving God. Those who love their neighbor and do these things are going to heaven as Jesus says they “inherit the kingdom.” On the other hand, those who do not do these things “will go off to eternal punishment.” So it looks like we better love each other!

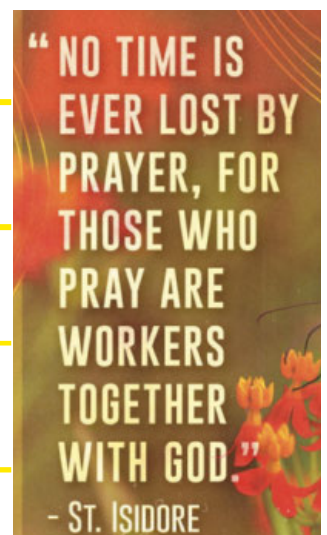

Christmas Outreach

Giving Tree and Adopt a Child

St. Patrick Outreach's Adopt-a-Child and Giving Tree programs are back! This year we continue to support children from the communities of St. Agnes Dorothy Day Room, St. Patrick's Norristown, Parkesburg Point, St. Francis de Sales Parish (Philadelphia), HOPE Partnership for Education (Philadelphia), LaSalle Academy (Philadelphia), and Mother of Mercy House (Kensington).

Adopt-a-Child: When you participate in the Adopt-a-Child program, you are committing to purchasing all the Christmas gifts for a child which is given directly to the parent/guardian of that child. Please plan to shop from the wish list form provided by the agency and plan to include wrapping paper and tape, or wrap the presents, if instructed to do so. These gifts would be the only presents the child will receive on Christmas. The suggested donation amount is \$200, but the exact amount is up to you. Currently, the parish has committed to 75 children.

Due to overwhelming interest in previous years, there is a maximum of 2 children per donor. This allows everyone to participate in the program.

Giving Tree: The Giving Tree gifts are provided to the various agencies for the parents/guardians to come and shop for their children from the gifts we provide. The suggested gifts are usually about \$20-\$40 each, but the exact price is up to you. The Giving Tree gifts will be divided among the Giving Tree in the back of Church and an Amazon Wishlist, beginning the week of November 13th. The Giving Tree will be placed in the back of church beginning the week of Thanksgiving for you to take tags directly from the tree.

Please plan to return your gift, with the tag attached to Church by Saturday, December 10th.
