Advent is a season of hope and expectation. May the coming days of this beautiful season find you in a place of peace and hope and fully awake to the working of God in your life.

#### From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With the beginning of the sacred season of Advent, we enter a new Year of Grace. We anticipate the celebration of the Birth of Our Lord, while we also wait with longing for the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, our King and Judge. This season is joyful in nature, especially as we celebrate the nearness of Christmas. However, Advent also calls us to be vigilant – through prayer, penance, and works of charity – for the return of Christ.

"Advent ... helps us to understand fully the value and meaning of Christmas. It is not just about commemorating the historical event, which occurred some 2,000 years ago in a little village of Judea. To predispose our mind to welcome the Lord who, as we say in the Creed, one day will come to judge the living and the dead, we must learn to recognize him as present in the events of daily life. Therefore, Advent is, so to speak, an intense training that directs us decisively toward him who already came, who will come, and who comes continuously" (Pope Saint John Paul II, printed in Christmas with the Holy Fathers).

In this new Year of Grace, may God grant that we marvel at the wonders of his love, and be ever attentive to the presence of Our Lord in everyday life. May we never forget that, also, as we see so much violence and war in our world, we are called to bear the love of God and into everyday life. May this new liturgical year find us willing to be peace-makers in the home and neighborhood, in the school and work place. May God show us his mercy and love!




