Staff Reflection

OUR DIVINITY

Do you truly believe with all your heart that you are divine? What can you do in your daily life that will help you to recognize your divine aspect? What leads you astray from the path to being truly divine? People seldom ask these questions, but it is important that we ask these questions and answer them as well. During eighth grade religion class we were asked these questions, and this is what we came up with.

Do you truly believe, with all your heart, that you are divine?

It can take a lifetime to answer this question, but we do believe that everyone is made in the image and likeness of our Heavenly Father, and we all need to work to realize our divine nature. Advent by Candlelight December 17th—7PM - 9PM

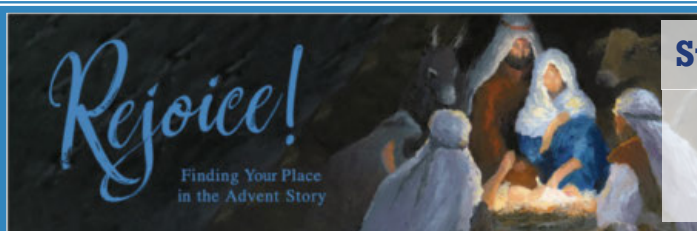

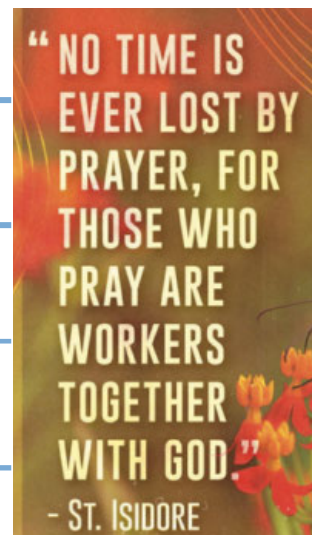

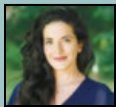
