Staff Reflection

Today we celebrate The Epiphany of the Lord. We are reminded that Jesus came into the world for all of us, for all people. Today it is not hard to find evil in our world and we must not let God slip away. We all know that Jesus humbled Himself in our humanity so we could share in His divinity. Therefore, we should do our share so as we respond in the Responsorial Psalm, "Lord, every nation on earth will adore you."
