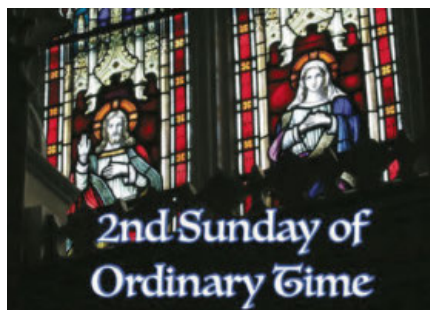

Staff Reflection

The first reading today is one of my favorite encounters in the Old Testament. Samuel was a young boy under the mentorship of Eli a older priest. There is a lot of extra context to this story and I encourage you to read the preceding chapters to go deeper, but for now let's just focus on the story at hand. Samuel is sleeping "in the temple of the LORD where the ark of God was" and God calls out to him, but Samuel misinterprets the Lord's voice for Eli's. This happens three times before Eli was able to help Samuel understand what was happening. With his instructions Samuel is able to take the next step and receive the Lord's message.

I think many of us experience this confusion when it comes to listening to God. We place ourselves before the Lord and don't always understand what we hear. It takes the help of another more experienced or wise person to lead us into the next step of our journey. There's a similar transition in the Gospel reading in which John the Baptist guides two of his disciples to Jesus. John proclaims to them, "Behold the Lamb of God." In response, the disciples leave John and become Jesus' disciples.

Both of these accounts are examples of good mentorship. Both Eli and John the Baptist point those in their care to God and encourage them to encounter the Lord on their own. They realize they are just a stepping stone in the journey of those in their care. This humility is such a stark contrast to our world today where much of our society stresses the importance of gathering as many followers as you can. Eli and John the Baptist get out of the way and point their followers to Jesus.

Now that we have transitioned from the Christmas Season to Ordinary Time it may seem like a let down. Christmas is all about acknowledging Jesus' incarnation, His coming into our midst. Its literally a season of Beholding the Lamb of God. Now that we've done that, what's the next step? Well, taking a cue from Andrew, the other disciple and Samuel, our next step could be to just listen or watch him. Jesus invited Andrew and his companion to "Come and see". Samuel's response was, "Speak Lord your servant is listening." Both of these postures exhibit an openness to following the Lord's lead and cooperating with whatever he asks.

Behold the Lamb of God!
