

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Brothers and Sisters: If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth" (Col 3: 1-2).

As we celebrate the glory of the Risen Lord, consider all of the mysteries which we have commemorated this week: The Lord's entry into Jerusalem, His Last Supper at which He instituted the Priesthood and the Eucharist, His Passion and Death, and now His glorious Resurrection. Christ has conquered death and He bids us come forth from all that holds us back to live in the joy of new life. We must not be weighed down by the things of this world. Rather, we must remember that we are created to share eternal life with God in Heaven. Christ has conquered and we must not be afraid to immerse ourselves in the wonders of His Risen life.

Pope Francis instructs us: "We cannot live Easter without entering into the mystery.... 'To enter into the mystery' means the ability to wonder, to contemplate; the ability to listen to the silence and to hear the tiny whisper amid great silence by which God speaks to us.... The women who were Jesus' disciples teach us all this. They kept watch that night, together with Mary. And she, the Virgin Mother, helped them not to lose faith and hope. As a result, they did not remain prisoners of fear and sadness, but at the first light of dawn they went out carrying their ointments, their hearts anointed with love. They went forth and found the tomb open. And they went in. They had kept watch, they went forth and they entered into the Mystery. May we learn from them to keep watch with God and with Mary our Mother, so that we too may enter into the Mystery which leads from death to life" (Homily, Easter Vigil 2015).

As mentioned previously, as an Easter gift to all our Parishioners, Saint Patrick Parish has subscribed to FORMED. 


