From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this Third Sunday of Easter, we return to the Upper Room and Jesus reveals Himself to His Disciples. He shows them His wounds. He invites them to touch Him. He eats fish in their presence. Jesus is fully alive! The Lord who is risen desires us to be His witnesses – witnesses to hope and holiness in the world. This sacred season of Easter invites us to rekindle our reasons for having hope in the midst of the turmoil of the world.

In his 2018 *Apostolic Exhortation Gaudete et Exsultate ("Rejoice and Be Glad")*, Pope Francis addressed the universal call to holiness in the today's world. All of us, without exception, are called to live holy lives. This cannot be something we simply think about. This is something we must live. Nor is it overly complicated. Holiness is found in the everyday and ordinary. We need to fine-tune our ability to recognize this fact. Pope Francis states, "I like to contemplate the holiness present in the patience of God's people: in those parents who raise their children with immense love, in those men and women who work hard to support their families, in the sick, in elderly religious who never lose their smile. In their daily perseverance I see the holiness of the Church militant. Very often it is a holiness found in our next-door neighbors, those who, living in our midst, reflect God's presence. We might call them 'the middle class of holiness'" (*Gaudate et Exsultate*, 7).

Today, in the Parish Center, we are hosting our Ministry Fair. Sponsored by our Next Generation Parish Committee, the Ministry Fair showcases the many and varied ministries and services which add to the vibrancy of Saint Patrick Parish. I am very grateful to Julia Goldschmidt and all of the members of Next Generation Parish, as well as all who volunteer in any way. Please come over and view the many opportunities for service. Coffee and doughnuts will be available in the Parish Center as well. Consider how and in which ministry our Lord is calling YOU to enhance the life and mission of Saint Patrick Parish! See you there!




